

Great Rolling Pin Challenge Entry

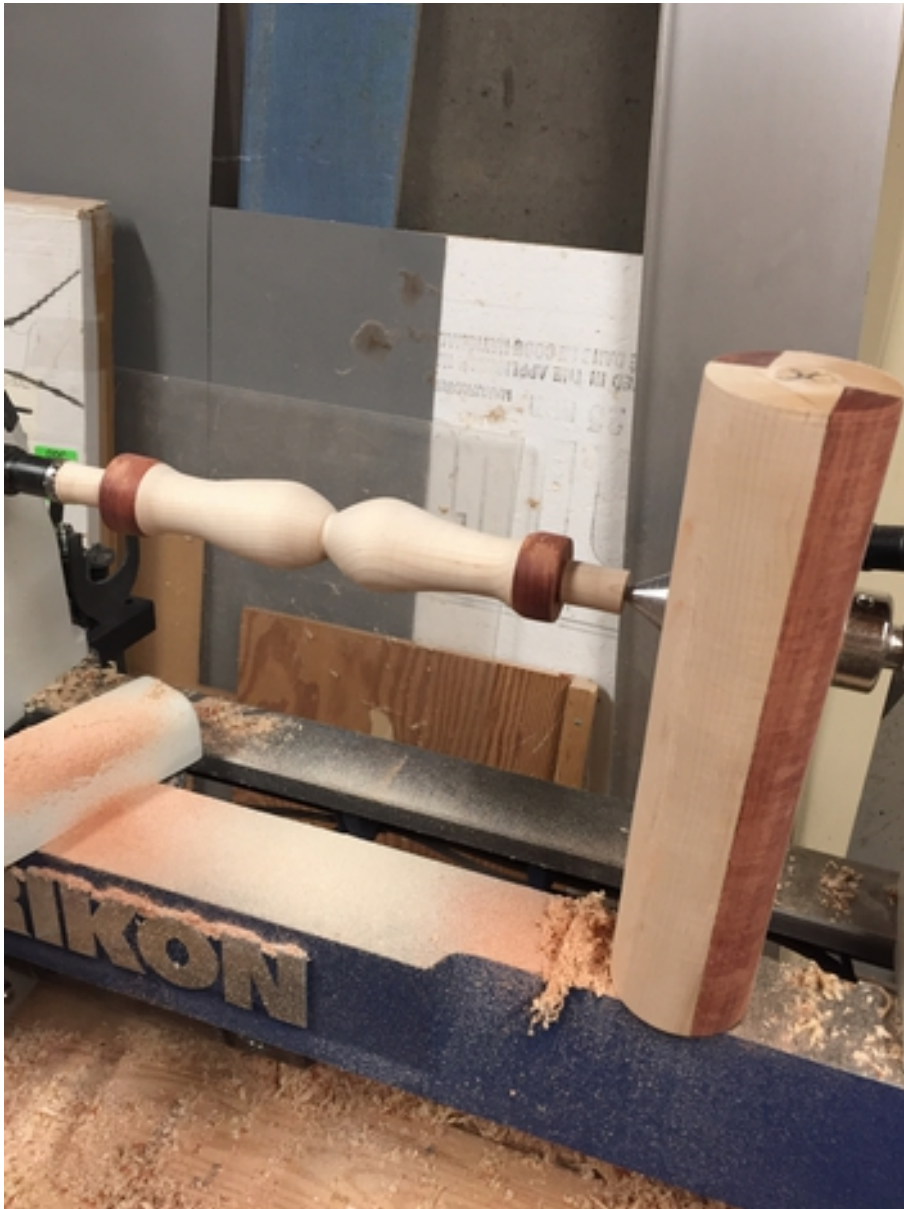
Overall length: 19.5 in.

Barrel length: 10.75 in.

Barrel width: 2.5 in.

Wood: maple, bloodwood

The handles are stationary by choice. Although allowing the handles to turn freely is common, there is some thought that free turning handles “bulldoze” the dough rather than flatten it as French rolling pins do. When it comes to baking / pastry, I figure the French can’t be wrong and therefore opted for fixed handles.



As a cautionary note, I was told bloodwood might bleed into adjoining wood and therefore possibly the dough when used. While hoping this will not be the case, I obviously should have given my choice of wood more thought than simply appearance.

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
