While following the steps suggested by the Alumilite Super Mimi Casting Kit, Warman was able to make a perfect case of a tool tip, which ultimately can be used for reference each time you visit the grindstone. The focus of our January meeting was 'How to Use & Sharpen Hollowing Tools'. Stuart Taylor did a great job of leading the discussion while at the same time demonstrated his prefered use of the hollowing tools which he owns. Like many of us, Stuart confessed that much of his learning has come by way of trial- and-error,

and that there may be several different ways of approching hollow turning. After Stuart had hollowed part of a blank and answered several questions, he then gave us a demonstration regarding his method of sharpening the cutters he uses for hollowing. All-in-all the demonstration was very informative.
