March Meeting



For those of you who unfortunately missed our March Meeting, we had a spectacular visit with John McNab in his shop/studio, located close

to Pier 21. One has to see John's creations to comprehend, as he uses a three-story vertical lathe with elliptical gears to create

exotic flame like sculptures.

He glues up hollow forms, either in staves or in segments, to make rough shapes.

Then he modified a patternmaker's lathe with gears and a leadscrew and put an industrial router on the toolpost, this causes the router to cut spirals, much like the ornamental lathers of Victorian times..

The patternmaker's lathe was too small so he built a vertical lathe that will allow him to make spirals twenty

feet long. His gear train now includes elliptical gears, that he made himself, to get ever more exotic shapes.
